Bridge Inspections Requiring Lane Restrictions to Occur in Ross and Pittsburgh

PITTSBURGH – The Department of Public Works announced today that bridge inspection work will occur in Ross Township and the City of Pittsburgh from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the following dates, weather permitting:

- Wednesday, May 12 and Thursday, May 13 – Bellevue Road Bridge, which carries Bellevue Road between Nazareth Way and McIlrath Drive in Ross Township. There will be periodic single-lane closures on the bridge and underneath the bridge on state-owned I-279 (Parkway North).
- Wednesday, May 12 and Thursday, May 13 – Jack’s Run Bridge No. 3, which carries Jacks Run Road between Bellpark Drive and Kane Lane in Ross Township. There will be periodic single-lane closures on the bridge and underneath the bridge on state-owned I-279 (Parkway North).
- Friday, May 14 – Ivory Avenue Bridge No. 1, which carries Ivory Avenue between Sovereign Street and Nelson Run Road in the City of Pittsburgh. There will be periodic single-lane closures on the bridge and underneath the bridge on state-owned McKnight Road (Route 19).

Drivers are urged to use caution near the bridges while work is taking place.

The inspections are being done by Fisher Associates of Canonsburg.
